As we exit July, we reflect on the importance of National Minority Mental Health Awareness and BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) Mental Health, noting that the work we do is never limited to a single month. Our current **Community Behavioral Health Plan**, created by the Mid Shore Planning Collaborative (MSPC), focuses on systemic disparities on the shore impacting BIPOC and other minorities. Goal 2, found on page 168, states we will "Strategically address the impact of social determinants across the lifespan," with the first objective to, "Recognize the role of systemic social injustice and racial inequity and how it inhibits wellness in the mid-shore community." Specific strategies follow. This important work continues year round for MSBH and our partners in MSPC.




