

## Mid Shore Roundtable on Homelessness Continuum of Care (CoC) Annual Program Competition Rating and Ranking Procedures for New and Renewal Project Applications

The Mid Shore Roundtable on Homelessness Executive Committee is tasked with reviewing all new and renewal project applications submitted for the CoC Program Competition. The Committee is nominated and selected at the beginning of the fiscal year.

The CoC sets a deadline for project applications to be submitted into ESnaps. Following submissions of the project applications by the set deadline, the Executive Committee will decide which projects will be approved to be ranked or if they will be denied. Project applicants are then notified via email on the status of their application, and whether or not it will be included in the current year's application.

Next, the CoC will convene to review all applications that were approved to be ranked using objective criteria provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

After all project applications have been given a ranking, the CoC will post the final rankings to the CoC website, as well as distribute to the Roundtable distribution list.
