Kent County Schools Served through Consortium Grants
2025-2026 school year

The Maryland Consortium on Coordinated Community Supports was created by the Maryland General Assembly as part of the Blueprint for Maryland’s Future to expand access to comprehensive behavioral health services for Maryland students, pre-K through grade 12. Through the Consortium program, over \$97 million was awarded statewide for the 2025-2026 school year. Four Consortium grants serve Kent County, and they are projected to serve over 1400 students during the 2025-2026 school year. Below is a short description of each of the four programs. A list of schools served is attached.



Boys and Girls Clubs. This grantee offers social-emotional skill building and character development through after-school activities.



Choptank Community Health System. This grantee offers co-occurring individual therapy, care coordination, substance use prevention, suicide prevention, family groups, and family support delivered through school-based health centers (SBHCs).



The Cook Center for Human Connection. This grantee offers parent coaching, school staff training, and promotes positive classroom environments.



For All Seasons. This Grantee offers individual and family therapy, telehealth, support groups, psychiatric care, medication management, mindfulness, and mental health literacy programs. Bilingual services are also available.
